Tentative Ruling on Petition for Change of Name: Petitioners Heidi Stewart and Monte Stewart, guardians of the minor Korey Elsea Potter, petition for change of minor's name to Korey Ann Stewart. No proof of publication has been submitted. The Court requires a Certificate of Publication from the publishing newspaper before the Petition may be granted. No proof of service has been filed. The guardian must provide notice of the hearing to any living parent of the minor by personal service at least 30 days before the hearing. CCP § 1277 (f)(1). This matter is continued to **Monday, August 29, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition. **No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

IN RE: HINZE

Case Number: 22CV-0199611

Tentative Ruling on Petition for Change of Name: Petitioners Melva Hinze and Herb Quinn, grandparents and guardians of the minor Jakoby Crimson Rose Croy, petition for change of the minor's name to Jakoby Lowe Quinn. Proof of publication has been filed. No proof of service has been filed. The guardian must provide notice of the hearing to any living parent of the minor by personal service at least 30 days before the hearing. CCP § 1277 (f)(1). This matter is continued to **Monday, August 29, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition. **No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

GUARDIANSHIP OF KAYDEN SARTAIN

Case Number: 22PG-0031487

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for Further Proceedings regarding a Petition for Appointment of Guardian, status of service, to confirm conflict counsel, and submission of the ICWA form. The Petition was filed by the minor's maternal aunt (Cheyenne Webb). Letters of Temporary Guardianship issued on April 6, 2022. The Temporary Guardianship's powers are set to expire today unless further extended.

The mother has consented to the appointment and waived notice. The father has objected to the appointment. The Court has dispensed with notice to the maternal grandmother at a previous hearing. The Court has reviewed the Declaration filed by Cheyenne Webb and will dispense with notice to the maternal grandfather. The Court will not dispense with notice to the paternal grandfather. The Court previously directed Petitioner to serve the paternal grandparents who may be served by mail, however, service must be made at least fifteen days in advance of the hearing. Prob. Code § 1511. Here, 15 days' notice was not given. The Indian Child Inquiry Attachment (Judicial Council form ICWA-010(A) has been submitted but has not been completed correctly. In order to check a box in Item 3, the second box in Item 2 must be checked. This Petition was originally filed April 5, 2022. The Petitioner has been ordered multiple times to file all of the required documents and to timely give notice to all parties entitled to notice. Petitioner has failed to comply with the Court's orders. The Court has appointed conflict attorney Aneke Stokes as counsel for the minor. The Court has reviewed the Court Investigator's report, filed April 20, 2022, which recommends denying the Petition. **An appearance is necessary on today's calendar to address whether the temporary guardianship should remain in place.**

GUARDIANSHIP OF SCOTT AND RONNIE SCHAFER

Case Number: 22PG-0031542

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of a Guardian of the Person of minors Scott Schafer and Ronnie Schafer. The Petition was filed by the minors' maternal grandfather Emidio Salazar. Letters of Temporary Guardianship issued on May 26, 2022. The Letters are set to expire today unless extended.

There is no proof of service of the Notice of Hearing for the mother, father, maternal grandmother or paternal grandparents. Insufficient information has been provided to permit the Court to dispense with notice to these parties. The parents must be personally served in order to move forward on the Petition. Prob. Code § 1511(b). All other parties may be served by mail. Prob. Code § 1511(c). The Indian Child Inquiry Attachment (Judicial Council form ICWA-010(A)) has been submitted for both minors. The Court has reviewed the Court Investigator's report filed June 22, 2022 which recommends granting the Petition.

This matter is continued to **Monday, August 8, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition. The Temporary Guardianship is ORDERED to remain in effect until the continued hearing date. Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a new Notice of Hearing, along with a copy of the Petition, for the continued hearing date on the parties identified above. In the alternative, if Petitioner cannot serve the parties identified above, the Court will require a declaration explaining why they cannot be served and the efforts of Petitioner to locate and serve the parties identified, in order to permit the Court to dispense with notice to the parties. **Warning: Failure to properly effect service or provide adequate basis to dispense with service as to the necessary parties will result in denial of the Petition. Notice is preserved. No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

GUARDIANSHIP OF TYANA WHITE HAWK

Case Number: 22PG-0031557

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of a Guardian of the Person of minor Tyana White Hawk. The Petition was filed by a non-relative, Jonnalyn Denny. Per the Indian Child Inquiry Attachment (Judicial Council form ICWA-010(A)), the minor is an Indian child. It has been represented that the minor is currently under guardianship through the Fort Peck Sioux Tribe in Montana, however, the Court does not have documentation regarding a tribal guardianship. The Court notes that the Certified Mail Receipt for the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of the Fort Peck Indian Reservation has been returned signed. The Court requests that a representative of the Tribe appear to inform the Court whether a tribal guardianship exists and whether the Tribe intends to intervene. An appearance may be made via WebEx as described above.

The current guardian, Latoya Demarrias, has not been served. The father and mother have only been served by mail. The current guardian and parents must be personally served in order to move forward on the Petition. Prob. Code § 1511(b). There is proof of service on file for the maternal grandparents and the paternal grandmother. The paternal grandfather must be served. The paternal grandfather may be served by mail. Prob. Code § 1511(c). The Court has reviewed the Court Investigator's Report dated June 27, 2022 which does not make a recommendation regarding the guardianship.

The Court intends to continue this matter to **Monday, August 1, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition. Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a

new Notice of Hearing, along with a copy of the Petition, for the continued hearing date on the parties identified above. In the alternative, if Petitioner cannot serve the parties identified above, the Court will require a declaration explaining why they cannot be served and the efforts of Petitioner to locate and serve the parties identified, in order to permit the Court to dispense with notice to the parties. **Warning: Failure to properly effect service or provide adequate basis to dispense with service as to the necessary parties will result in denial of the Petition. Notice is preserved.**

No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.

GUARDIANSHIP OF AALIYAH NOALAN

Case Number: 22PG-0031564

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of a Guardian of the Person of minor, Aaliyah Noalan. The Petition was filed by the minor's aunt (Tia Coulter). Letters of Temporary Guardianship issued on May 25, 2022. The Temporary Guardianship's powers are set to expire today unless further extended.

The mother has been personally served. The Court dispenses with notice to the unknown paternal grandparents. There is no proof of service of the Notice of Hearing for the father or maternal grandparents. Insufficient information has been provided to permit the Court to dispense with notice to these parties. The parents must be personally served in order to move forward on the Petition. Prob. Code § 1511(b). All other parties may be served by mail. Prob. Code § 1511(c). The Court Investigator has requested a continuance to complete its investigation. The Court notes that the Petition fails to provide the ICWA Attachment (Judicial Council Form ICWA-010(A)). Without this form the Court cannot determine whether notice is required under ICWA. The mother has filed an objection to the Petition. The Court appoints the Public Defender as counsel for the minor. Finally, the Amended Confidential Guardian Screening Form fails to provide attachments 6 and 14.

This matter is continued to **Monday, July 25, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition and for confirmation of counsel. The Temporary Guardianship is ORDERED to remain in effect until the continued hearing date. Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a new Notice of Hearing, along with a copy of the Petition, for the continued hearing date on the parties identified above. In the alternative, if Petitioner cannot serve the parties identified above, the Court will require a declaration explaining why they cannot be served and the efforts of Petitioner to locate and serve the parties identified, in order to permit the Court to dispense with notice to the parties. Petitioner shall also file the ICWA Attachment (Judicial Council Form ICWA-010(A)) and a Second Amended Confidential Guardian Screening Form with attachments prior to the continued hearing date. **Warning: Failure to properly effect service or provide adequate basis to dispense with service as to the necessary parties will result in denial of the Petition. Notice is preserved.**

No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.

GUARDIANSHIP OF MAKAYLA LINDSTROM

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of a Guardian of the Person of minor, Makayla Lindstrom. The Petition was filed by non-relatives,

Norman Turner & Ellen Fulkerson. Letters of Temporary Guardianship issued on May 25, 2022. The Temporary Guardianship is set to expire today unless further extended.

The minor, father, and paternal grandmother consent to appointment of the Petitioners. The Court dispenses with notice to the unknown maternal grandparents, deceased paternal grandfather, and deceased mother. The matter has been properly noticed. No objections have been raised. The paperwork appears to be in order.

The Court has reviewed and considered the CFS report filed June 17, 2022 and agrees with the recommendation to grant the Petition. The Court **FINDS** it would be detrimental for the child to be with either parent or any parent objecting to the guardianship, the guardianship is in the child's best interest, and the guardianship is necessary and convenient. The proposed guardian is suitable.

The Court **GRANTS** the Petition. Visitation shall be at the Guardian's discretion. A proposed Order Appointing Guardian has been lodged and will be executed by the Court. Annual Review is set for **Monday, June 26, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12.** **No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

GUARDIANSHIP OF NORA & ROXIE O'CONNOR

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of a Guardian of the Person of minors, Nora and Roxie O'Connor. The minors are currently under a separate Guardianship with Case No. 26630. A Petition for Appointment of Successor Guardian must be filed in the existing case. The Petitioners are ordered to re-submit their Petition in Case No. 26630. In light of the foregoing, this matter is **DENIED** without prejudice. **No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for further proceedings on a Petition for Termination. The name of the Petitioner is not identified on the Petition in item 1, but from the caption appears to be the co-Guardian Lori Overby. The minor, parents and grandmother Daisy Rivera all consent to the termination. There is no proof of service on the other Guardian Kim Bowman or the other grandparents. As Petitioner was previously informed at the prior hearings on March 14, 2022 and May 9, 2022, the Petition cannot be granted until all necessary parties have been served. The Court still requires service on the other guardian and other grandparents. In the alternative, the Court requires sufficient evidence to dispense with notice to these parties. The Court has reviewed the CFS report filed on October 29, 2021, and will accept that report related to current Petition for Termination. This matter is continued to **Monday, August 8, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12** for further proceedings on the Petition for Termination. Petitioner shall file and serve a Notice of Hearing for the continued hearing date on the individuals identified above. **A failure to serve the required individuals may result in the denial of the Petition. The siblings have now been served timely by mail. The father was personally served less than 15 days before today's hearing. The Court notes the prior efforts to contact and serve the father. Based on those efforts the Court will deem the service on the father valid. The matter has been properly noticed. No objections have been raised. The paperwork appears to be in order.

The Court has reviewed and considered the CFS report filed May 17, 2022 and agrees with the recommendation to grant the Petition. The Court **FINDS** it would be detrimental for the child to be with either parent or any parent objecting to the guardianship, the guardianship is in the child's best interest, and the guardianship is necessary and convenient. The proposed guardian is suitable.

The Court **GRANTS** the Petition. Visitation shall be at the Guardian's discretion. A proposed Order Appointing Guardian has been lodged and will be executed by the Court. Annual Review is set for **Monday, June 26, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12.** **No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.**

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition to Fix Residence filed by the guardians, Grace and Justin Fry. The mother has consented to the out of state move. There is no proof of service indicating that the father has been served. The father may be served by mail. Prob. Code §§ 2352(b), 1460(a), 1511(b) and 1215.

This matter is continued to **Monday, August 1, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12.** Petitioner is ordered to file and serve a new Notice of Hearing with the continued hearing date on the parties identified above. In the alternative, if Petitioner cannot serve the parties identified, the Court will require a declaration explaining why they cannot be served and the efforts of Petitioner to locate and serve the parties identified, in order to permit the Court to dispense with notice to the party. **Warning: Failure to properly effect service or provide adequate basis to**

dispense with service as to the necessary parties will result in denial of the Petition. Notice is preserved. No appearance is necessary on today's calendar.

GUARDIANSHIP OF ANASTACIA SEROTA

Tentative Ruling: This matter is on calendar for hearing on a Petition for Appointment of Guardian of the Person of minor, Anastacia Serota. The Petition was filed by the minor's paternal aunt, Lisa Ward. Letters of Temporary Guardianship issued on February 7, 2022. The Temporary Guardianship's powers are set to expire today unless further extended.

The father and minor have signed consent and waiver of notice forms. Based on the mother's appearance at the prior hearing, the Court has dispensed with notice to the mother. The paternal grandparents and maternal grandmother have been timely served with a notice of hearing. The Court dispenses with notice to the maternal grandfather. The matter has been properly noticed. No objections have been raised. The paperwork appears to be in order.

The Court has reviewed and considered the Court Investigator's report filed February 24, 2022 and agrees with the recommendation to grant the Petition. The Court **FINDS** it would be detrimental for the child to be with either parent or any parent objecting to the guardianship, the guardianship is in the child's best interest, and the guardianship is necessary and convenient. The proposed guardian is suitable.

The Court **GRANTS** the Petition. Visitation shall be at the Guardian's discretion. A proposed Order Appointing Guardian has been lodged and will be executed by the Court.
